

Community Reunion Group Coordinator (CRGc)

The role of this portfolio is to ensure that the community embraces Reunion Groups, and to help new pilgrims/caterpillars and others who are not in groups to become members of a Reunion Group or to form a new one where required. Reunion Groups are for any Christian who is a pilgrim on the journey of faith and who desires to live a life of accountable discipleship. Fourth Days must remain a priority for the Board and the community.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

- Be an active member of a Reunion Group.
- Study Chapter 12 of the Upper Room Handbook regarding Reunion Groups carefully. A Sponsorship booklet compiled by the Upper Room is also available for ordering from the EMSA Supplies Board member.
- Encourage Reunion Groups to host Gatherings (which can also be used for fundraising) and if they are willing to do so, advise the CLD and CGC.
- Keep regular contact with the Reunion Group leaders in the community.
- Visit each Reunion Group at least once a year together with the CSD, CLD and Board Agape member if possible.
- Host a Reunion Group workshop annually to encourage Fourth Day activity, sponsorship, Walk, program volunteers and entertainment and to share agape ideas.
- Give Reunion Group leaders new ideas, constant support and encouragement.
- Remind Group leaders of Gatherings and Walk dates.
- Provide Reunion Group leaders with a list of team and pilgrim/caterpillar names before a Walk/Flight for letters.
- Provide particulars of Reunion Groups to the for the Fourth Day packs.
- Provide sufficient information to all Reunion Group leaders about their role and responsibilities according to the Upper Room Handbook.
- Encourage Reunion Groups to be active over the Walk, Flight or Encounter event by preparing agape, attending weekend events, offering to do the entertainment, participating in the 72-hour Prayer Vigil, etc
- Maintain contact details of Reunion Group leaders and share these with the ITC for updates to the website.
